### Instructions

- Strip old bedding from stall.
- For 12' x 12' Stalls, start with 5 bags on rubber mats, 6 - 7 bags without rubber mats.
- Remove manure as usual. Do not remove any Woody Pet until it has expanded into fluffy bedding throughout the stall. This normally takes 2 - 7 days, depending on how much time your horse spends in the stall.
- It is important to mix the dry bedding daily with the bedding that has absorbed moisture.
- Once the Woody Pet Bedding is activated (fluffed up) start removing the fresh patches of urine soiled bedding on sight.
- Replenish daily or weekly by adding 1/3 the amount of bedding you have removed. Average stalled horses will use up to one bag per week after the bedding has been activated.
- With diligent urine patch removal, Woody Pet bedded stalls need complete stripping approximately every 2 - 5 months.
- (Optional) Once you have placed the new Woody Pet Bedding in your stalls, moisten it with water. This will make it fluff up 3 - 4 times in depth. When using this method it is important to start removing the fresh patches of urine soaked bedding on sight.

### Recommendations

After the new Woody Pet has expanded into fluffy bedding, it is important to maintain a very light moisture content throughout the bedding in the stall. This will eliminate any airborne dust and will also assist the bedding with holding in the ammonia odors. Spray with a light application of water if necessary.

When manually activating Woody Pet Bedding with water, do not oversaturate. Adding too much water will directly effect the performance of your Woody Pet Bedding.

Mix the bedding in your stall daily by pulling it from the wall areas and mix it with the bedding at the centre of the stall. This allows the drier bedding to draw excess moisture from the surrounding bedding. This only takes a minute.

Remove any dark or red patches that appear in the bedding. These dark patches are areas that have been oversaturated with urine and are the result of improper urine patch removal and/or not having enough bedding in the stall. Not removing these dark patches will result in unwanted ammonia odors.

Woody Pet bedding is not intended for ingestion.

## SUPERIOR LITTER & BEDDING FOR ALL ANIMALS



### Small Animal Cages and Litter Trays

Remove old bedding / litter, replace with Woody Pet. Start with 3/4 to 1 inch in most cages and litter trays. Always remember; Woody Pet will fluff up 3 to 4 times in depth. Woody Pet lasts longer and will control ammonia odors.

### Poultry

Activate with moisture. Depth in poultry houses should not exceed 1/2 to 3/4 of an inch.

### Moisture & Odor Control

Using Woody Pet with other bedding material will assist in controlling moisture & odors.

### Shop Absorbent

Spread over petroleum, oil, antifreeze spills or under leaking machinery. Sweep up as required.
